# BHH Services

**Comprehensive Care Management**— Determine if client is due for any vaccines. If client receive a vaccine, make it a goal to ensure the client receives recommended vaccines.

**Care Coordination**— For clients who should receive a vaccine, work with their primary care physician and other providers to ensure that clients receive vaccine as close to the recommended schedule as possible.

**Health Promotion**— Educate clients on the recommended vaccine schedule, importance of vaccines, and the different diseases that vaccines work to prevent.

**Comprehensive Transitional Care**— If a client has been hospitalized and missed recommended vaccines, ensure that clients are able to receive vaccines upon his or her discharge.

**Patient and Family Support**— Provide patients and their families with information they need to make sound decisions around vaccines and immunizations.

**Referral to Community Support Services**— Find support groups, events, or community organizations that can help educate clients on vaccines and immunizations.
