Individuals may be eligible for BHH services if they meet all of the following criteria:

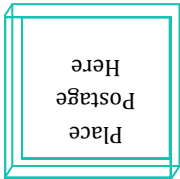
- Diagnosis of a serious and persistent mental illness

- Medicaid claims in excess of \$10,000 in a year

What is a Behavioral Health Home?

A Behavioral Health Home (BHH) is not a house or housing program, but is a multi-disciplinary team providing CT Medicaid eligible, children and adults, with services that will help improve physical and behavioral health. The no cost, care coordination team provides assistance with:

Health information and screenings

Finding Medical Providers

Transportation Assistance for appointments

Planning a return home from a hospital stay

Quitting smoking (if and when you are ready)

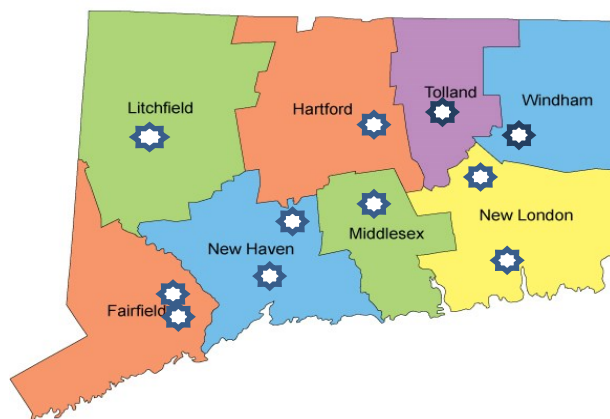
Reducing alcohol or drug use
